Dear Carnival CDC Families,

We hope this letter finds you well and in great health. First, we want to thank everyone for your support and cooperation with our health and safety guidelines as our center continues to proactively respond to the unexpected invasion of COVID-19. We know it isn't always easy, but we are doing our very best to keep a sense of normalcy all while following state and CDC guidelines.

With that being said, we want to inform our School Age Parents of our tentative plan for transporting our children to and from school for the year 2020-2021. I'm sure many of you are aware of the phased schedules that Mayfield Heights and South Euclid Lyndhurst has proposed. In order for us to stay in compliance with ODJFS regarding ratio's and other guidelines, we **WILL NOT** be able to provide transportation until all children are phased into their school districts. In other words, our transportation will begin as followed:

For South Euclid – Lyndhurst student's our transportation will begin on **September 4th, 2020.**

For Mayfield City Schools Elementary and Middle School student's our transportation will begin on **August 24th, 2020.**

For Mayfield City Schools Kindergarten student's, our transportation will begin on **August 27th, 2020**

We understand that during the first week of the school year, phased in students are only going to school one day that week. We want to make it clear to all families that you **CAN** bring your child/children to Carnival on their off days and you're more than welcome to arrange transportation to/from Carnival on the day your child has school until we start transportation on the dates listed above. As of now, this is our plan but if any school district changes their phasing schedule, we will plan accordingly and let everyone know.

Lastly, we have been getting a lot of inquiries on rather we are eligible to house children whose parents have signed up for virtual learning. We have been in communication with ODJFS and the Ohio Department of Education; therefore, as of now we are **NOT** allowed to have school age children on site during school hours unless schools are closed for any reason. However, we were informed that this is subject to change and if or when it does, we will notify our parents immediately.
